MOHR-FRY RANCHES OLD VINES, LODI

Notes of: Raspberry, Blackberry, Spicy Earth

In 1996 Jerry Fry loaned us 7 tons of beautiful Old Vine Zinfandel after our vineyard died of phylloxera. Nearly 30 years later, our Mohr-Fry Ranch Zinfandel has won countless awards, has become our flagship wine, and has set the standard for Lodi Zinfandel.

VINEYARD

Mohr-Fry Ranches home ranch sits directly south of the city of Lodi, on 225-acres comprised of 9 blocks of own-rooted old vine zinfandel, dating back to 1901. In our opinion, these vineyards produce some of California's best Zinfandel wines, consistently ripening beautiful grapes.

WINE NOTES

A classic Lodi Zinfandel made in a style to highlight the rich raspberry and spicy blackberry fruit character of these old Lodi Zinfandel Vine-yards. Picked ripe and hand sorted the grapes were fermented at cool temperatures for 7 days. Gentle pumpovers and delestage helped lend balance. The wine was pressed and racked to 60 gallon American and French Oak barrels (15% new) for 10 months barrel aging. A natural malolactic fermentation was completed in barrels.
